Costco Wholesale has 5.4 points more reputation than the average for Ecommerce & Online Retail.

EXPERT VERDICT

Costco is refreshingly low on linguistic bullshit, opting for a cold, utilitarian presentation of facts and prices. However, the 'substance' of the site is crippled by technical infrastructure failures that render large portions of its value proposition inaccessible. It is a site that tells the truth in its copy but fails to deliver the content in its code.

INFO DENSITY

Power-words vs. Substance ratio.

The site exhibits exceptionally high information density with a low power word ratio. Headings such as H2 Find a Warehouse and H2 Customer Service are purely functional, avoiding generic descriptors like world-class or revolutionary. Body text includes specific substance like Valid 5/11/26 - 6/7/26 and concrete financial incentives like Spend \$1,999 save an additional \$300, which provides verifiable data over marketing fluff.

SEMANTIC COHERENCE

Homepage promise vs. Sub-page reality.

The primary semantic drift is technical rather than linguistic. While the Homepage promises a broad range of products from electronics to jewelry, 50% of the strategically selected sub-pages (Grocery and Optical) return an Access Denied error, and the Cart view triggers a Page Not Found response. This creates a severe disconnect between the signal of a comprehensive online warehouse and the substance of a broken navigation path.

TRUST & PROOF

Verifiable evidence vs. Trust Theatre.

DIAGNOSIS: TRUST THEATRE

Trust theatre is detected on system pages where it should not exist. The CheckoutCartView page, which results in a Page Not Found error, strangely displays a review_count of 12 and has the trust_theatre_flag set to true. Furthermore, while the homepage shows 592 reviews, there is only 1 proof_link_count, indicating a reliance on internal, unverified review displays.

EVIDENCE: PROOF DENSITY

The ratio of verifiable evidence to assertions is high on the homepage, featuring exact promotional dates and specific dollar-amount savings. However, the proof density collapses on sub-pages due to technical errors. The presence of 592 reviews without a third-party verification link (proof_links_count: 1) suggests a medium risk of trust theatre regarding customer feedback.

COMMODITY FINGERPRINT

Detection of industry cliches/templates.

The site avoids standard ecommerce cliches like boutique or artisan-crafted, instead using industry-specific but functional terms like Member-Only savings and warehouse prices. The value proposition is unique to the membership-model retail sector and cannot be easily copy-pasted by generic competitors. However, boilerplate template fingerprints like About Us and Customer Service are heavily repeated in the heading hierarchy.

IDENTITY & AUTHORITY

Expert verifiability & Schema depth.

DIAGNOSIS: AUTHORITY GAPS

There is a significant technical authority gap as the homepage contains null for schema_json, failing to provide structured data to support its enterprise status. While the brand authority is high, the digital footprint is undermined by broken technical implementations across 4 out of 6 crawled pages. No named experts or Person schema are present to anchor specific service claims in Optical or Grocery.

EVIDENCE: PERFORMANCE VS. CLAIMS

The homepage claims of everyday values and low warehouse prices are substantiated by specific discount tiers (e.g., Spend \$2,499+ save \$500) and membership limits. The main disconnect occurs where the site claims to be a one-stop shop for grocery and optical services, yet those pages are inaccessible in the crawl, rendering the claims unsubstantiated by evidence.

INDUSTRY CLASSIFICATION

The content strongly confirms the Ecommerce & Online Retail classification through warehouse-specific terminology and membership-based value propositions. The presence of transactional elements like tiered appliance discounts and warehouse location finders aligns with a high-volume retail model.

"The score of 69 is driven primarily by technical failures and trust theatre flags on non-content pages. The site scores very low (meaning high substance) in Information Density and Commodity Fingerprint due to its focus on hard numbers and unique business model. The Identity and Authority pillar is the highest penalized due to the lack of structured data and high page error rate."
