INFO DENSITY

Power-words vs. Substance ratio.

The site exhibits high tactical density, favoring technical instructions over generic power words. For example, the What is on-page SEO? page provides a granular 10-step manual including specific references to Yoast checklists and internal link 'orphan pages.' However, while substance is high, numerical density is low; the text lacks specific outcome data such as percentage increases in traffic or revenue for named clients, relying instead on descriptive expertise.

SEMANTIC COHERENCE

Homepage promise vs. Sub-page reality.

There is zero detectable semantic drift between the homepage signal and sub-page delivery. The homepage H1 '3 Steps to Fix your SEO' is directly supported by sub-pages providing the 'Audit,' 'Strategy,' and 'Monthly' components promised. The identity of a specialist agency for WordPress websites is maintained rigorously across Surrey-specific landing pages and educational blog content.

TRUST & PROOF

Verifiable evidence vs. Trust Theatre.

DIAGNOSIS: TRUST THEATRE

The site displays a high review_count of up to 285 on the customer reviews page, yet the proof_links_count remains low at 1 or 2 per page, suggesting a lack of direct verification links to third-party platforms like Clutch or Google Business Profiles within the body text. While the reviews name actual companies like LexisNexis and Fireworks for Africa, the absence of a verified outbound proof path for every claim prevents a perfect score.

EVIDENCE: PROOF DENSITY

The proof density is moderate; the site successfully utilizes named client testimonials (e.g., Peter Enslin, Yosheni Naidoo) which include specific job titles and company names. However, the ratio of verifiable evidence to assertions is dampened by the total absence of formal, data-heavy case studies that quantify the 'measurable results' mentioned in the industry dictionary.

COMMODITY FINGERPRINT

Detection of industry cliches/templates.

The value proposition avoids generic agency traps by explicitly stating 'We work on WordPress websites,' which creates a functional niche. It does use some industry cliches such as 'proven track record' and 'boost traffic,' but these are usually attached to specific deliverables like 'Product Page Optimization' or 'Target Keyword Rank Tracking.' The presence of a free 'Website Content Plan Template' differentiates the lead magnet from the standard 'Free Audit' commodity.

IDENTITY & AUTHORITY

Expert verifiability & Schema depth.

DIAGNOSIS: AUTHORITY GAPS

Authority gaps are non-existent due to robust structured data and identity transparency. Michelle Fouche is clearly identified as the founder with a consistent digital footprint across JSON-LD sameAs links to LinkedIn and Facebook. The Organization schema is properly implemented with founding dates (2000-05-01) and legal names (TLD Projects Pty Ltd), establishing a long-term professional history.

EVIDENCE: PERFORMANCE VS. CLAIMS

A minor disconnect exists where the site claims to produce 'SUPER fast' websites in testimonials, but fails to show actual Lighthouse or PageSpeed Insights scores for those projects. Bold assertions about sustainable gains are made without providing a single baseline-vs-current traffic graph to substantiate the claims of effectiveness.

The site perfectly matches the Marketing and SEO Agency category, specifically positioning itself as a WordPress-focused technical specialist. The content across all six pages consistently addresses search engine optimization, website planning, and WordPress maintenance without shifting into unrelated services.

"The score of 78 is driven primarily by the lack of hard numerical data (Information Density) and the limited use of outbound proof links (Trust and Proof). The site achieved a perfect 0 in Semantic Coherence and Identity/Authority, indicating a highly professional and transparent digital presence that backs up its core marketing promises."
