## INFO DENSITY

Power-words vs. Substance ratio.

The site exhibits high substance, specifically on the business registration page where it provides granular fee tiers such as \$9,562 CAD for large firms and \$2,575 CAD for small businesses. While some headings like [H1] The Icon is Your Beacon contain metaphorical power words, the body text immediately grounds these claims in technical specifics like token identifiers and advertising IDs. The ratio of specific nouns to marketing adjectives is significantly higher than industry averages, citing named entities like Ad Standards and various trade associations.

## SEMANTIC COHERENCE

Homepage promise vs. Sub-page reality.

There is virtually zero drift between the homepage signal and sub-page substance. The homepage H1 What is Interest-Based Advertising? sets an educational tone that is rigorously supported by the detailed compliance guides and news updates found on deeper pages. The transition from consumer-facing education on the homepage to professional fee structures on the registration page is logically consistent and maintains a unified organizational identity.

## TRUST & PROOF

Verifiable evidence vs. Trust Theatre.

### DIAGNOSIS: TRUST THEATRE

The site reports a review\_count of 6 to 10 across various pages, yet these reviews lack external verification links to platforms like Google or Trustpilot, which triggers a minor trust theatre flag. However, this is largely mitigated by the presence of proof\_links\_count = 2 and clear outbound links to the independent enforcement body, Ad Standards. The claims of compliance are backed by a public news archive featuring specific compliance reports from 2023, 2024, and 2025.

### EVIDENCE: PROOF DENSITY

Proof density is high, with the site listing exactly six founding member associations (ACA, A2C, CMA, etc.) and providing a clear 'Participation Comparison Table.' Every major claim regarding consumer control is paired with a functional tool or a named third-party enforcement partner, representing a 4:1 ratio of evidence-backed claims to general assertions.

## COMMODITY FINGERPRINT

Detection of industry cliches/templates.

The site avoids most agency clichés like growth hacking or ROI-driven, though it does utilize some value proposition cliches such as Builds trust and responsible corporate citizen. The structure uses standard templates like About Us and DAAC News, but the content within these blocks is highly specific to the Canadian regulatory landscape, making the value proposition impossible to copy-paste onto a generic competitor.

## IDENTITY & AUTHORITY

Expert verifiability & Schema depth.

### DIAGNOSIS: AUTHORITY GAPS

Authority is well-established through the listing of a full Board of Directors and Staff, including Julie Ford (Executive Director) and Caroline Moul (Chair). A minor gap exists as these individuals are not currently connected to individual Person schema or sameAs LinkedIn profiles within the structured data, though the Organization schema itself is robust and includes valid address and social media data.

### EVIDENCE: PERFORMANCE VS. CLAIMS

The disconnect is minimal because the DAAC does not promise marketing 'results' like revenue or traffic. Instead, it claims to provide a 'self-regulatory program,' which it proves through the existence of its 'Choice Tools,' a public complaint mechanism, and an independent accountability partner. The 'Strong Compliance' claims are dated April 8, 2026, making them extremely current relative to the May 2026 analysis date.
