There is zero usage of generic power words without accompanying named entities or technical nouns.

TRUST & PROOF

DIAGNOSIS: TRUST THEATRE

The site incurs a minor penalty due to a Trust Theatre flag where a review_count of 39 is displayed without corresponding proof_links_count. While the content itself provides internal proof through citations of Reuters and Anthropic, the lack of external verification links for subscriber reviews triggers a mandatory score according to the forensic framework.

A technical authority gap exists because the site lacks structured schema_json (Organization or Person schema) despite claiming high authority. While the digital footprint of the named expert, Ben Thompson, is massive within the text, the absence of SameAs links in the metadata to verify social or academic footprints results in a technical identity penalty.

EVIDENCE: PERFORMANCE VS. CLAIMS

There is no disconnect between marketing tone and demonstration. The site makes no bold promises of 'success' or 'results' for the reader, focusing instead on the performance metrics of the companies it analyzes (e.g., Nvidia's B200 networking capabilities or Cerebras IPO pricing).
