The site exhibits a total absence of business-related information, resulting in a high points penalty for specificity absence. The H1 [Welcome to nginx!] is a technical placeholder with 0 percent fluff but also 0 percent business substance. The body substance ratio is penalized because the text consists entirely of server confirmation rather than specific business claims, numbers, or outcomes.

SEMANTIC COHERENCE

Homepage promise vs. Sub-page reality.

Semantic drift across pages cannot be measured due to the lack of sub-pages, but the drift between the domain intent and the current [H1] is absolute. The heading hierarchy is incoherent for a business entity, failing the requirement that a reader should understand what the business does from headings alone. The only promise made is a successful server installation, which is a total disconnect from commercial positioning.

TRUST & PROOF

Verifiable evidence vs. Trust Theatre.

DIAGNOSIS: TRUST THEATRE

There is no trust theatre present because the site makes zero commercial claims; the review_count and proof_links_count are both 0. However, the site receives a maximum penalty for proof path absence as it contains no external links to case studies, certifications, or third-party validation. The site exists in a vacuum without any verifiable digital footprint.

EVIDENCE: PROOF DENSITY

The proof density for commercial claims is zero, as there are 0 instances of named clients, frameworks, or measurable business results. The only verifiable evidence provided relates to the nginx software installation itself, not to any business entity or service. The ratio of verifiable business evidence to vague assertions is null.

DIAGNOSIS: AUTHORITY GAPS

There is a total authority gap as the site contains no schema_json, no Person schema, and no named team members.
